


FITMENT Position the pack to sit in the center of

BUTTERFLY HARNESS The key to the security and fit of the Turbo RR is the 4-way adjustable butterfly




HYDRATION ROUTING The Turbo RR uses a 2L 70 oz hydration bladder. Unzip the hydration compartment located on the backside of the bag. Slide the hydration bladder and hose into the hydration pocket. Rout the hose through either slot located at the top of the pack.


From there, route the hose through the D-ring on the chest harness and stick the hose to the velcro patch to keep it secure

To remove the bladder pull the hose back into the main compartment and remove as a single unit. Do not unscrew the hose unless you are sure the bladder is
