
## Exhaust Heat Shield Mounting Instructions




To install the heat shield, feed included hose clamp through the 2 slots on the heat shield and slightly tighten.




With the heat shield positioned, continue to tighten until snug. Once mounted, double check location and that your Panniers or saddlebags will not touch the exhaust.



Slide the heat shield and hose clamp over your exhaust and position for optimal protection.



With your mounting location confirmed, use a pair of pliers or metal shears to cut off the excess hose clamp.
